International Yoga Day

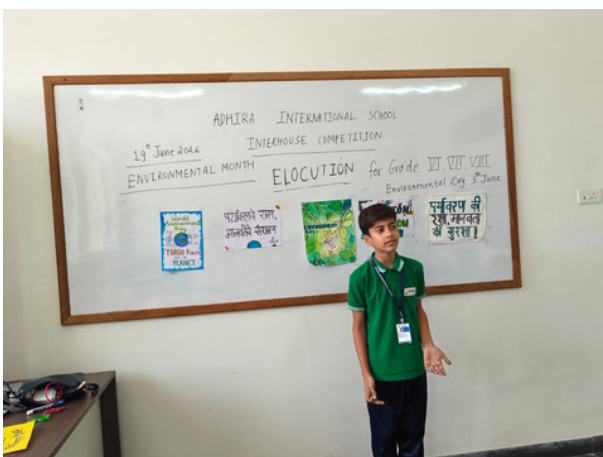
